

ONLINE / FACE TO FACE

The student can choose to complete the Master's degree either online or in a face-to-face format.

Face to face: Taught at the ENAIRE facilities in Madrid (Parque Empresarial Las Mercedes) during weekly evening sessions.

Online: students can access the classes remotely through streaming video-conference, or later through an e-learning platform.

Both modes offer online tutorials with the instructors, as well as access to the Master's Classes programme, taught by renowned experts and relevant aviation professionals. These classes are streamed and then uploaded to the learning platform.

The classroom mode includes extra activities related to each module:

- Visits to ENAIRE's facilities: Madrid Control Centre, Madrid Barajas Control Tower, simulators...
- Networking initiatives with ENAIRE senior management: A space to exchange experiences and current challenges in the sector with our leading professionals.
