



## ENAIRe's Control Centre in Seville managed 41,545 flights in July, an increase of 5%

- Domestic traffic grew by 11.8% and overflights by 7.8%.
- Of the 41,545 total flights, 20,749 were international.
- Air traffic in the entire ENAIRe network is up 2%, with 220,719 flights in Spain, and the number of overflights rising 6% and domestic flights 5.4%

### 14 August 2019

ENAIRe, the Spanish air navigation manager, closed out the month of July with 41,545 flights controlled by the Seville Control Centre, 4.9% more than in the same period in 2018. Particularly noteworthy was the increase in domestic flights (+11.8%), which totalled 10,527.

The number of international flights also went up, to 20,749, an increase of 0.5%.

Overflights (not taking off from or landing at a Spanish airport) grew by 7.8% (10,269 in July).

### Southern Region

ENAIRe's Seville Control Centre manages an airspace of 179,000 square kilometres that covers Andalusia, the province of Badajoz, part of Ciudad Real, Albacete and Murcia, the entire Bay of Cádiz and the entire western Mediterranean, as well as Ceuta and Melilla.

### ENAIRe network total

In July 2019, ENAIRe managed a total of 220,719 flights, 2% more than in the same month last year. In addition, the growth in domestic traffic increased by 5.4%, to 41,285 flights. Overflights went up by 6% (2,608 more than in 2018). However, international flights decreased by 0.3% from 133,739 to 133,376.

Note: The total for ENAIRe's network does not match the sum of the flights scheduled by each Control Centre (CC). This is due to the fact that a flight is registered according to the air space and route it crosses. For example: a flight departing from Adolfo Suárez Madrid-Barajas Airport to Barcelona-El Prat Airport will be registered in the Madrid CC and Barcelona CC.

### Cumulative from January to July

ENAIRe has managed 1,238,633 flights so far this year, 4% more than in the same period in 2018.

Through July, the Seville Control Centre managed 245,447 flights, an increase of 7.5%.

### About ENAIRe

ENAIRe is the company belonging to the Public Works Department that provides air navigation services in Spain. It renders aerodrome control services at 21 airports, including the busiest in terms of air traffic, plus en-route and approach control, from five control centres: Barcelona, Madrid, Gran Canaria, Palma and Seville. In addition, ENAIRe provides communications, navigation and surveillance services to 45 air control towers.

In 2018 ENAIRe handled 2.1 million flights to and from four continents (Europe, America, Asia and Africa), transporting 300 million passengers.

ENAIRe is the fourth most important European air navigation service provider, and, in a clear commitment to the Single Sky initiative, belongs to international partnerships such as SESAR (Single European Sky ATM Research) Joint Undertaking, SESAR Deployment Manager, A6, iTEC, CANSO (Civil Air Navigation Services Organisation) and ICAO (International Civil Aviation Organization).
